

## FRE 211 Intermediate French I

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: DRE 097 or ENG-002 and FRE 112 with minimum grade of C; or satisfactory score on placement test

Corequisites: None

This course provides a review and expansion of the essential skills of the French language. Emphasis is placed on the study of authentic and representative literary and cultural texts. Upon completion, students should be able to communicate effectively, accurately, and creatively about a variety of topics.
