

MED 110 Orientation to Medical Assisting

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Prerequisites: Enrollment in Medical Assisting Diploma, or AAS degree

Corequisites: CIS 110, ENG 111

This course covers the history of medicine and the role of the medical assistant in the health care setting. Emphasis is on professionalism, communication, attitude, behaviors, and duties in the medical environment. Upon completion, students should be able to project a positive attitude and promote the profession of medical assisting.

Course Hours per Week: Class, 1; Lab, 0; Semester Hours Credit, 1.
